The current facility, located at 440 North Ferry Street in Grand Haven, is no longer adequate for the needs of a rapidly growing community. The Land Acquisition consultant will assist the agency in acquiring the needed amount of property for the new facility.

Funding for the facility will come mainly from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) and as such, must adhere to the guidelines of the FTA.
